Willy was born at Ernabella Mission on 15th September 1937. Willy was a hard working man and in his younger years he worked with his brother-in-law Robert up the Birdsville Track. Willy also had the opportunity to work with the Willis brothers Lenny, Tommy, Dean and Andy (dec), also Johnny Johns (dec) and Glen Hull (dec) at Bon Bon Station. In 1968 Willy met and married Raylene Baker (Ugoo) at Wirraminna Station of that same year. They moved to Coondambo Station and settled down and had their six children: Priscilla, Melissa, Gary, Brenton, William Jnr (dec) and Jodie.

In the late eighties his daughter Priscilla took him back to visit family at Amata. Willy spent time with his cousin Muyuru and brother-in-law Leonard Burton at their homeland. Upon Willy's return to Port Augusta he was taken in by his niece Faye who had a special relationship with her uncle and cared for him during this time. As he got older Willy became sick and had to be placed in the Wami Kata Old Folks Home at Davenport. Within his last months, he was transferred to the Port Augusta Hospital due to illness until his passing on the 10th August 2005. Willy was known as a happy go lucky person by the Davenport Community and never passed anyone without saying hello.
