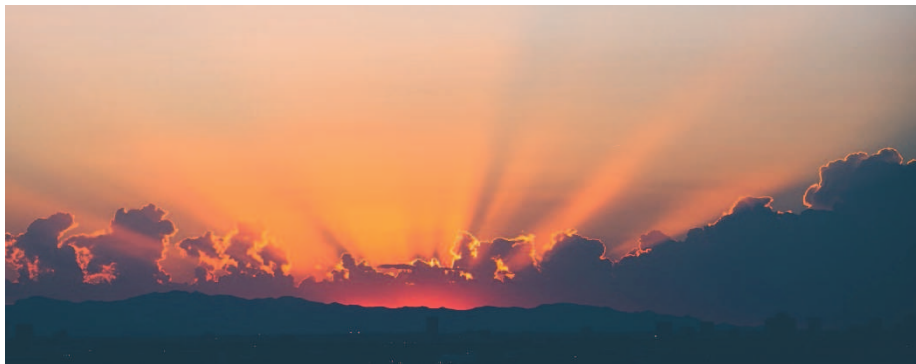

Aldon was born in Port Augusta on the 7th of January 1970, the youngest son of Maudie Ryan and Phillip Arkaringa. He had two older brothers Lynton and Grantley.

Sadly Aldon was born with both mental and physical disabilities and this made his life very difficult from birth.

When he was only 6 years old sadly his mum passed away. At this sad time he came to live with Lilly and Robert Neville and their family.

It was very difficult as he could do very little for himself. However, the Neville family loved him and his brothers and they found a way to cope.

Lilly used to take him to Adelaide for his Doctors appointments and that meant catching a bus and then a train leaving at 4 in the morning and not getting home until midnight. He loved the trips on the train and Lilly used to take him to the zoo on these trips and he really enjoyed seeing the animals.

He completed his schooling at Quorn Area School to year 11.

At the age of 17, he went to live in sheltered housing in Adelaide. This meant he could get the care he needed and also have his independence.

Life was tough for him and he lived many years with no fixed address, but he did live from time to time with Gloria and also at Julie's.

He made friends in the sheltered housing and he used to visit them in Malala and he also went to Sydney and Melbourne for holidays.

Sadly, he was not in contact with family when he passed away on the 5th of May in 2017 and so no-one knew. The Neville family found out by an advert in the Advertiser asking for family to make contact. The family now trust in the Lord that he is now peacefully at rest.
