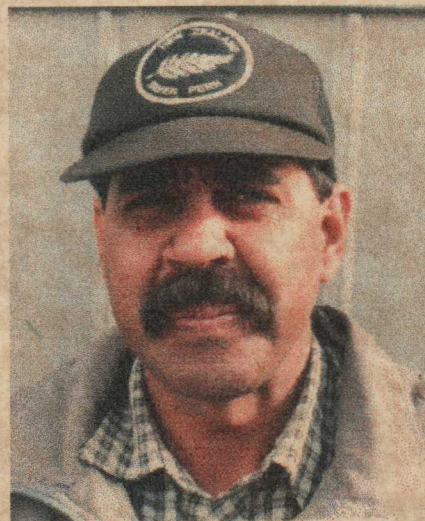

Dennis Wayne Woods

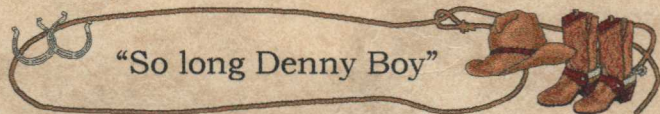
